Distinguished - To a varsity team/activity that achieved a 3.00 to 3.49 GPA during their season.

Outstanding - To a varsity team/activity that achieved a 3.50 to 4.00 GPA during their season.

<u>Season</u>	<u>Grading Period</u>	<u>Deadline</u>
Fall Sport	First nine weeks GPA	November 30
Winter Sport	Third nine weeks GPA	April 21
Spring Sport	Fourth nine weeks GPA	June 15

All varsity team/groups that participate in activities sponsored by the WHSAA are eligible. The team/group shall be defined as those individuals on the varsity team/group who are on the eligibility list for that activity when the season for that activity ends.

CALCULATING GRADE POINT AVERAGES

The team grade point average (GPA) shall be calculated by determining the average of the cumulative GPA's of all team members from the grading period(s) during which that activity took place. Those team members must have participated in the culminating event.

CRITERIA FOR CULMINATING EVENTS

FALL ACTIVITIES

Cheerleading - Those students who participate on a fall squad recognized and sponsored by a member school.
Minimum – 4

Cross Country - If the cross country team takes the full compliment of the maximum of 7 runners and a minimum of 4 runners, the full team is eligible.

Dance - Those students who participate on a fall squad recognized and sponsored by a member school.
Minimum – 4

Football - Those students who were on the varsity team at the end of the season are eligible.
Minimum – 11 (6 for 6 man football)

Golf - Those students who participated at State Golf, 3 girls and 4 boys per team are eligible.

Journalism - Those students who participated in the State Journalism Convention are eligible.
Minimum - 6

Marching Band - Those students who participated in the State Marching Band Contest are eligible.
Minimum - 6

Swimming Girls - Those students who participated in the State Swim Meet are eligible.
Minimum - 6

Tennis - Those students who participated in the State Tennis Meet are eligible.
Minimum - 6

Volleyball - Those students who were on the varsity team roster for the regional tournament are eligible.
Minimum - 6

WINTER ACTIVITIES

Band - Those students who participated in the district music clinics and/or All-State Music Concert are eligible.
Minimum - 6

Basketball Those students who were on the varsity team roster for the regional tournament are eligible.
Minimum - 6

Cheerleading - Those students who participate on a winter squad recognized and sponsored by a member school.
Minimum - 4

Choir - Those students who participated in the district music clinics and/or All-State music Concert are eligible.
Minimum - 6

Dance - Those students who participate on a winter squad recognized and sponsored by a member school.
Minimum - 4

DECA - Those students who participated in State DECA are eligible. Minimum - 1

Drama - Those students who participated in the State Drama and Thespian Conference are eligible. Minimum - 6

Indoor Track - Those students who participated in the state track meet are eligible. Minimum - 6

Orchestra - Those students who participated in district music clinics and/or All-State Music Concert are eligible.
Minimum - 6

Skiing - Those students who participated in the State Ski Meet are eligible. Minimum - 6

Speech - Those students who went to the State Speech Meet are eligible. Minimum - 6

Student Council - Those students who participated in the State Student Council Convention are eligible. Minimum - 6

Swimming Boys - Those students who participated in the State Swim Meet are eligible. Minimum - 6

Wrestling - Those students who participated in the regional wrestling tournament are eligible.
Minimum - 6

SPRING ACTIVITIES

Art - Those students who participated in the State Art Symposium are eligible. Minimum - 6

FBLA - Those students who participated in State FBLA are eligible. Minimum - 6

FCCLA - Those students who participated in State FCCLA are eligible. Minimum - 6

FFA - Those students who participated in the State FFA Leadership Conference are eligible.
Minimum - 6

SkillsUSA - Those students who participated in State SkillsUSA Competition are eligible. Minimum - 6

Soccer - Those students who were on the varsity team at the end of the season are eligible. Minimum - 11

Softball - Those students who were on the varsity team at the end of the season are eligible. Minimum - 9

Track - Those students who participated in the regional track meet are eligible. Minimum - 6
