Tournament Passes

Each team will receive the following passes for the tournament: 12 player passes, 2 manager passes, 3 coach passes, 1 bus driver pass, and 3 spouse passes.

Games/Cameras

All games will be played at the LVHS Fieldhouse, Aux Gym, or Lander Middle School. Games will not be started early. All games will be available on the NFHS Network.

Home Team

The team on top of the bracket will be the home team and sit to the right of the scorer's table as you face it. Brackets are included.

Cheerleaders and Pep Bands

Please let me know if you plan to bring cheerleaders or a pep band.

Team Picture and Roster

Rosters and team pictures need to be current on MaxPreps.

Rosters

WHSAA Rule 7.15.61: No more than twelve players can be in uniform for any contest. The twelve players whose names are entered on the official scorebook for the first tournament contest, shall be the only players used for the entire tournament. Violation of this provision shall cause forfeiture as per WHSAA Rules 5.07 and 1.4.0.

Pregame Warmup

There will be a minimum of a ten minute warm-up. Please do not take the floor before it has been swept. No one will be allowed on the gym floor at half-times.

Videotaping

An area for videotaping will be provided for filming on the west or east side cat walks. You will need to provide your own extension cord.

Webcasts

Any live telecasts or video replays are subject to rights fees established by the WHSAA Board of Directors. Please let me know if anyone is planning on streaming games. The fee is waived if you are a member of the NFHS Network. All games in the Fieldhouse, Aux Gym, or Lander Middle School will be streamed on the NFHS Network.

Locker Rooms

Locker Rooms will be assigned, but also shared. Please take belongings with you. Fremont County School District 1 will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Towels will not be provided. It is a busy day re: locker rooms as Lander is hosting Powell, too.

Water

Water will be provided at the end of the bench, not cups. Water containers must be screw-top or snap-on lids and must be non-glass.

Officials

Officials are assigned by the WHSAA.

Awards

Awards will be presented immediately following the award games. Name plates will be awarded to teams finishing in the top four. Individual medals will be awarded to the 1A West Regional Champions. All awards are provided by the WHSAA.

Game Management

Each School is expected to provide an administrator for supervision during each of their games. FCSD1 is not responsible for crowd control. An administrator for each participating teams needs to be present in their fans' section to deal with immediate crowd control issues.
