Torrington High School is excited to host this year's 3A East Regional Basketball Tournament on March 2nd -4th, 2022. Please read carefully the attached information concerning the tournament.

TEAM RECORD – QUADRANT SEEDING FORM: Will need to be submitted on a Google Docs form at the end of your games on Saturday February 25th, 2022. No later than Sunday at 9am.

ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION: All-Conference Selections will take place on Thursday, March 3rd in room 108. Girls after the 4:30 game. Boys after the 7:30 game. Meetings will begin when each school is represented. The meetings will be conducted by Absaraka Conference ADs. We will have you submit your nominations by using a Google Doc form. See attached link.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented immediately following the games played which determine third and first place. The first four teams will be recognized and presented with a plate for their regional plaques. Twelve individual medals will be presented to the championship teams. Both Regional Champions will also be presented with the Absaraka Conference traveling trophy. **2022 Regional Champions – please remember to bring the traveling trophy with you to the tournament.**

BENCHES/HOME-VISITOR: The top team on the bracket will be the **HOME** team on the bench and on the scoreboard and will wear **WHITE** jerseys. As you look at the score table, the **Home** team will sit on the bench to the **left (East)** and the **Visiting** team to the **right (West)**.

BANDS: If you are bringing a band, they will be placed in the northwest and southeast corners of the gym in the second deck. If you are the home team the band will be placed in the southeast corner. Visiting opposite in the northwest corner.

BANNERS/NOISE MAKERS: Signs made of non-rigid materials such as Styrofoam, cloth and paper are permitted. Signs may be no larger than can be held by one person. No sign or flag supports of rigid materials such as wooden dowels, paint paddles, golf club shafts, etc., will be allowed. Artificial noisemakers, such as air horns, cowbells, megaphones in the crowd, sirens, clackers, etc., are not allowed in the gym. Unusual noise at any activity that is created by fans or participants that would interfere with the competition or the enjoyment of the fans is prohibited. Torrington High reserves the right to remove any item or person that is causing disruption to the game or is deemed unsportsmanlike in nature.

Attendance is a PRIVILEGE – Please help in getting this information to your parents and fans planning to attend the tournament.

BUS PARKING: Team buses will drop off/pick-up teams and park in our bus loop on the north side of Torrington High School (**map attached**).

CHEERLEADERS: Cheerleaders will be placed on the northeast and northwest ends of the gym floor. Home northeast, Visiting northwest. There will be no locker room available so cheerleaders will need to come dressed.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be provided by THS Choir in our concession stand located in the commons of THS.

HOSPITALITY ROOM: THS will have a hospitality room for coaches, officials, tournament workers, school administrators, bus drivers, and spouses.

LOCKER ROOMS: THS will assign locker rooms for teams. Torrington High School and the Absaraka Conference will not be responsible for theft. Please make sure you secure your valuables. Towels will not be provided.

NET REMOVAL: Nets may not be removed after any tournament game per WHSAA rule.

OFFICIALS: Tournament officials are assigned by the WHSAA.

TOURNAMENT PASSES: Tournament packets will be presented on your initial arrival. Your packet will include twelve (12) player passes, three (3) manager passes, three (3) coaches' passes, three (3) passes for coaches' spouses, and one (1) bus driver pass.

PREGAME WARM-UP: **Your** team will be guaranteed at least ten (10) minutes of warm-up time prior to each game. Games will not start earlier than the scheduled time. **No warm-ups will be allowed during the half-time of the previous game.**

RADIO STATIONS: All teams will be able to broadcast games. Radio crews will be placed mid-court on the second deck on the north side.

ROSTERS: Your team roster should be entered into the official scorebook at least ten (10) minutes prior to your first game. This roster may include no more than twelve (12) names. No more than twelve (12) players may be in uniform during any game. Your team roster may not change once it is officially entered into the scorebook for your first game.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Spectators, students, teams, and coaches are expected to display good sportsmanship. Each school is responsible for the conduct of their spectators, students, teams and coaches. There should be an administrator present from each school to control their crowd. Spectators displaying poor sportsmanship could be asked to leave the facility.

ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO-FREE CAMPUS: NO alcohol or tobacco products are allowed on our campus – use is prohibited on all school property.

TRAINER: North Platte Physical Therapy will be available to provide medical assistance during the tournament.

Streaming: All games will be streamed on the NFHS Network. Spectators must purchase a pass online to watch the streamed games.

UNIFORMS: The **TOP** team in each bracket will be designated the **HOME** team and will wear **WHITE** jerseys. The **BOTTOM** team in each bracket will be designated the **VISITING** team and will wear **DARK** jerseys.

Warm Up Balls: Torrington High School will provide all warmup balls. Please ***do not*** bring any basketballs into the gym.

VIDEOTAPING: Schools are allowed to videotape their games. All video equipment must be set up in the designated area – Behind the scorer's table in the second deck of the gym.

WATER: THS will provide water and cups for both benches during the entirety of the tournament.

3rd & 4th place games: These games will only be played if the 2 teams have not already played during the tournament. If the two teams have previously played the winner of that contest shall be the #3 seed and the loser shall be the #4 seed. Games will be listed on the bracket as (If Necessary)
