Tournament Site

All games will be played at Mountain View High School main gymnasium

Pass/Packet Information

Tournament packets will be available when you arrive at the tournament. Packets will include 15 player & manager passes (wrist bands), 3 coach passes, 3 spouse passes, and 1 bus driver pass.

Please let Dustin Rees know how many cheerleader/sponsor passes will be needed for your school by February 13th. If you are not sending your cheerleaders please let me know ASAP. If you need additional passes, you may contact Dustin Rees at the site. Athletes must have their passes to enter the school. Packets will also include all other necessary information.

Bus Loading/Unloading & Parking

Please unload and pick-up the basketball players at the main entrance to the athletic wing of the high school building. Buses, **DO NOT PARK IN THE HIGH SCHOOL PARKING LOT**. Buses please park at the Baptist Church on 7th Street near the main entrance to MVHS.

Ticket Prices

Regional ticket prices have been set by the WHSAA. Individual sessions (morning and afternoon) will cost \$5.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students. All-session prices are \$23.00 for adults and \$20.00 for students. Students must present their Student ID to be admitted at the student price.

Seating:

To try to manage the crowd and to ensure enough seating for all games, we have added aluminum bleachers in the corners and behind the baskets at each end. We ask that any students who plan to stand during the course of the game sit in the aluminum benches on the same side that their team is sitting on. **We also would like to reserve the bleacher section behind each bench for the fans and parents of that particular team. We ask that these seats be cleared after each game to make room for the fans of the upcoming game.**

Tournament Seeding

Tournament seeding will be done as soon as all team records are received. Regardless of seed, **Mountain View Boys and Girls teams will play in the 2nd session on Thursday.**

Home/Visiting Team Designation

The team listed on the top of the bracket will be designated the home team, wear white uniforms and sit to the RIGHT of the scorer's table. The team listed on the bottom of the bracket will be designated the visiting team, wear dark uniforms and sit to the LEFT of the scorer's table. Mountain View Teams will ALWAYS sit to the RIGHT of the scorer's table.

Locker Rooms

Locker rooms will be assigned before each game. Mountain View High School will not be responsible for lost or missing items. Locker rooms will be made available approximately one hour prior to the scheduled game time.

Pregame Warm-ups

Coaches, please do not have your team take the floor until the floor has been swept. There will be a minimum of 12 minutes to warm-up. We will not begin a game before the scheduled start time. No teams will be allowed on the floor during halftime.

The practice gym will be available for shooting and warm-ups during the preceding game. The gym is only open to teams that are playing in the NEXT GAME.

Towels

Mountain View High School will not provide towels for participating teams.

Hospitality Room

Mountain View High School will provide a hospitality room for coaches, bus drivers, tournament workers and school administrators. No students will be allowed. The hospitality room will be located in the MVHS Cafeteria.

Water

Mountain View High School will provide water and cups on the team benches throughout the tournament.

Trainer. Darren Fiscus (Star Valley Health) will be onsite throughout the tournament. His office/training room is located in the auxiliary gym.

Concessions

Mountain View High School Sophomore Class will be providing a concession stand throughout the tournament for all of our fans.

Team Video

Teams will be allowed to videotape their games from a video platform located at midcourt at the top of the bleachers on the west side of the gymnasium.

Banners, Signs, Flags and Artificial Noise Makers

The items listed above are not allowed in the gym at any time during the tournament.

Awards and All-Conference Meetings

All-Conference meetings will be held on Friday, March 3rd, in the Mountain View High School library. The girls meeting will take place at 2:00 p.m. and the boys meeting will follow at 4:00 p.m. Selection of All-Conference players plus Conference Coach of the Year will take place at these meetings. Selection will follow the guidelines from the 3A West Constitution.
