## **Tournament Site**

All games will be played at Panther Gymnasium at Powell High School.

## **Packet Information**

Tournament packets will be available when you arrive at the tournament. Packets will include 12 player passes, 2 alternate passes, 2 manager passes, 3 coach passes, 3 spouse passes, and 1 bus driver pass. Please let Scott McKenzie know how many cheerleader/sponsor passes will be needed for your school by February 18<sup>th</sup>. If you need additional passes, you may contact Scott McKenzie at the site. Athletes must have their passes to enter the school. Packets will also include all other necessary information.

## **Bus Parking**

Please unload and pick up your athletes in the bus loading zone on the northeast side of the High School. This is a loading and unloading zone only. Please DO NOT drop off or pick up athletes at the front doors of the High School. All buses will need to park in the dirt lot on the east side of the football stadium. School will be in session on Thursday and Friday, therefore buses may not park in the bus loop during school hours.

## **Ticket Prices**

Regional ticket prices have been set by the WHSAA. Single session prices will be \$5.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students. All-session prices are \$23.00 for adults and \$20.00 for students. Students must present their Student ID to be admitted at the student price.

### **Rosters**

Rosters will be pulled from the MAXPREPS website. Please include the 12 players you plan to suit for the tournament. Rosters will be pulled on February 22<sup>nd</sup>.

### **Tournament Seeding**

Tournament seeding will be done as soon as all team records are received. Regardless of seed, the Powell High School Girls team and their opponent will play during the Game #7 slot at 7 p.m., Thursday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>. The Powell High School Boys team and their opponent will play during the Game #8 slot at 8:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### **Home/Visiting Team Designation**

The team listed on the top of the bracket will be designated the home team, wear white uniforms and sit to the left of the scorer's table. The team listed on the bottom of the bracket will be designated the visiting team, wear dark uniforms and sit to the right of the scorer's table. Powell will always sit to the left of the scorer's table regardless of being home or visitor in uniform color.

### **Locker Rooms**

Locker rooms will be assigned before each game. Powell High School will not be responsible for lost or missing items. Locker rooms will be made available approximately one hour prior to the scheduled game time.

### **Pregame Warm-ups**

Coaches, please do not have your team take the floor until the floor has been swept. There will be a minimum of 10 minutes to warm-up. We will not begin a game before the scheduled start time. No one will be allowed on the floor during halftime.

### **Towels**

Powell High School will not provide towels for participating teams.

### **Hospitality Room**

Powell High School will provide a hospitality room for coaches, bus drivers, tournament workers and school administrators. No students will be allowed. The hospitality room will be located in the Green Pod (off of the Commons area) in room 1097.

### **Water**

Powell High School will not provide water for the team benches throughout the tournament.

### **Training Room**

The training room will be available for use throughout the tournament. Please bring your training supplies. Powell High School trainer, Alan Hill, will be available for consultation throughout the tournament.

### **Concessions**

Powell High School Letter Club will be providing a concession stand throughout the tournament for all of our fans.

### **Team Video**

Teams will be allowed to videotape their games from a video platform located at midcourt at the top of the bleachers on the west side of the gymnasium.

### **Banners, Signs, Flags and Artificial Noise Makers**

The items listed above are not allowed in the gym at any time during the tournament.

### **Awards and All-Conference Meetings**

All-Conference meetings will be held on Friday, March 4<sup>th</sup>, in the Powell High School library, which is located off of the Commons area. The girls meeting will take place at 2:00 p.m. and the boys meeting will follow at 4:00 p.m. Selection of All-Conference players plus Conference Coach of the Year will take place at these meetings. Selection will follow the guidelines from the 3A West Constitution.

Coaches, you must be a member of the Wyoming Coaches Association in order to nominate your players for All-Conference and/or to receive Conference Coach of the Year. If you are not currently a member, please register by February 28<sup>th</sup>.

Girls' awards will be presented at half-time of the boys' championship game. Boys' awards will be presented at the conclusion of the championship game. Presentation will include the 3A West Conference Championship trophy, Coach of the Year and Regional team awards and medals. **\*\*If your school has the traveling trophy from 2019, please bring it with you to Regionals.**

### **Tournament T-shirts**

Powell High School will be selling 3A West Tournament T-Shirts and Hoodies throughout the tournament. We will send out a pre-order form for teams to order early.

### **Pep Bands/Cheer**

Bands, cheerleaders and dance teams are allowed to perform at regional and state culminating events, but are reminded that they are not allowed to play during live ball situations or during free throws. Please contact the Powell High School Activities office if your school band plans on performing at the tournament. Arrangements must be made prior to the tournament. Bands and cheerleaders will perform from designated areas.
