Riverton High School is pleased to host the 4A West Regional Basketball Tournament this year.

PROGRAM INFORMATION | Please send rosters and a clear, digital team photo to rmiller@fremont25.org by 2/24/2022.

SEEDING INFORMATION | Please email seeding information to Reggie Miller (rmiller@fremont25.org) by Sunday, February 27th at 9:00 am. Per 4A by-laws, the tournament will be seeded 1-8. If two teams have the same seed the North team will be the home team. Tie breakers will follow 4A by-laws, referenced on pages 3 & 4.

TEAM ENTRANCE AND PARKING | Officials and team entrance will be the Locker Room hallway by the Riverton Aquatic Center (west parking lot of Riverton High School). Coaches and athletes **ONLY** will be allowed to enter at this door, if teams can use the front door, it would be appreciated. Please have your bus driver drop you and your team off at the team entrance and park in the designated parking area for buses (near the Career Center). A map will be provided to you prior to the tournament. On Thursday or Saturday, while playing games at Riverton Middle School, it would be best to drop off the teams at the west parking lot entrance.

AWARDS | Each championship team will receive medals from State Farm. Award plates will be given for the champion, runner-up and 3rd and 4th place teams.

PRE-GAME WARM-UPS | We will give all teams ten minutes to warm up prior to the game. We are asking that teams refrain from warming up in the back hallway near the locker rooms in order to minimize any damage that may occur in that space. Teams are not allowed to shoot during the halftime of the game scheduled.

TRAINING ROOM | With our full time Athletic Trainer Ross Anderson on staff, the training room (at Riverton HS only) will be available for taping and injury prevention or evaluation.

GYMS AND SEEDING | Thursday and Friday games will all be played at Riverton High School; one site per conference by-laws. Saturday games will be played at Riverton Middle School and Riverton High School; allowable by conference by-laws.

TOURNAMENT SCORING | We would prefer the books filled out prior to the game, **BUT IT IS THE TEAM'S RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THE ROSTER AND STARTERS ARE REPORTED TO THE SCORER'S TABLE IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE PRIOR GAME.** Your commitment to be on time and your spirit of cooperation is essential to providing a successful experience for the athletes. Teams playing at CWC should have a scorekeeper (home) and timekeeper (visitor) available if needed.

BENCH SUPPLIES | We will furnish water and cups on the bench. You will need to furnish your own medical supplies and towels. We will have ice available in the training room for injured athletes. We will also have a trainer on hand at all times to assist you with injuries. They are there to support you, not to take over the situation. If any major injuries occur, the ambulance will be notified immediately, (the hospital is right across the street). There will not be an EMT on the premises.

TEAM PASSES | Upon arrival, you will receive an envelope containing passes for: *15 basketball players/managers, 3 coaches, 3 coaches' spouses, and 1 bus driver.* Athletes and managers will enter with their coaches prior to games.

HOSPITALITY ROOM | The Hospitality Room will be located in the Culinary Room @ RHS.

SPECTATORS | Your commitment to monitor your team's behavior while watching games is essential and greatly appreciated. Teams that are on-deck to play will have reserved seating in the first and second rows of bleachers on the northeast corner of the gym for visiting teams and the southeast corner of the gym for home teams. These areas will be roped off for your convenience. It is also expected that administrators and athletic directors from all schools will help monitor their fan's behavior. **We will have security, but your support is essential to help control the crowds as your staff knows your fans better than we do. We will ask that a staff member standby inside the gym entrance near the commons.**

LOCKER ROOM ASSIGNMENTS | At the high school, the home teams will use the Boys and Girls Varsity locker rooms, (#436 and #429) respectively (home teams are listed on the top of brackets). The visiting teams will use the Freshman/PE locker rooms, (#417 and #423). At Riverton Middle School locker rooms will be assigned upon your arrival. RHS and RMS will not be responsible for lost or stolen articles.

HALF-TIME ENTERTAINMENT | If you have a group that would like to entertain for half time, please make arrangements with Reggie Miller at (307) 856-6557, or by e-mail at rmiller@fremont25.org.

CONCESSIONS AND T-SHIRTS | Concessions will be sold at the tournament after 3:00 pm on Thursday and Friday and all day Saturday. If you wish to purchase team shirts, you will receive an email for purchasing them online. There will be a limited number sold onsite.

COACHES' MEETING | Boy's Coaches will meet at 8:15 am on Friday and Girl's Coaches will meet at 9:45 am on Friday in the James H. Moore Career Center CC 24 across the parking lot from the HS.

VIDEO | Video can be done at Riverton High School in the crow's nest or at the top of the bleachers at the middle school.

CHEERLEADERS | Cheerleaders may be at either end of the gym; all we ask is that they do not block our exits. Warm-ups must be completed prior to entering the gym. Valuables are the responsibility of the cheerleaders and coaches. During regional tournaments cheerleaders will be allowed up to 14 passes and 1 sponsor pass. Additional passes are available through arrangements with the RHS Activities Office.

High school students **MUST** present their WHSAA Identification Card or high school ID card in order to purchase tickets at the student price. If no ID card is presented, ADULT prices will be charged.

BANDS, CHEERLEADERS, AND DANCE TEAMS | Pep clubs, parents, and fans are reminded that pep posters, banners, and noise makers are not allowed at regional or state sites. Bands are allowed to play at regional and state culminating events, but are reminded that they are **NOT** allowed to play during live ball situations or during free throws. **If you have a band, cheerleading squad, or drill team that wishes to perform, please contact the RHS Activities Office as soon as possible.**

TABLE WORKERS | Each school is asked to provide the name and phone number of an individual that can serve in the capacity of a backup Table Worker or Ticket Taker in the event one of the RHS staff is pulled to cover security or another duty. Riverton High School is in session on Thursday and our regular staff will be unavailable for this duty, especially if you play at RMS.

RADIO BROADCASTING | We have 3-4 phone lines at Riverton High School and Riverton Middle School. If you are in need of a line, please contact Tim Bell at Riverton High School (307) 856-6557 extension 4003 to verify locations.

4A LEAGUE BY-LAWS APPLYING TO REGIONAL BASKETBALL

Tie Breaking Procedures:

- a. Head-to-head conference competition between and among the tied teams.
- b. If a tie still exists, compare the records of the tied teams against the record of the highest-ranking non-tied team. Continue through the Conference standings until the tie is broken.
- c. If a tie still exists, head-to-head conference competition between the tied teams at

common sites. (Season Tournaments)

- d. If a tie still exists, compare the records of the tied teams against the record of the highest ranking 4A non-conference opponent at a neutral site. Continue through the 4A non-conference standings until the tie is broken.
- e. If a tie still exists, the tie shall be broken with the flip of a coin.
- f. If it is a four-way tie, go to the WHSAA rulebook Rule 7.4.8 on Page 39.

ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION | A Google sheet will be shared with both boys and girls coaches to populate with your nominees. Guidelines for All-Conference are in accordance with 4A by-laws.

The coaches will select an All-Conference team and an All-State team the Tuesday following the state tournament. The meeting will be held in Casper and will be run by the commissioner of that sport. The all-conference and all-state selections will be determined in accordance with the following guidelines:

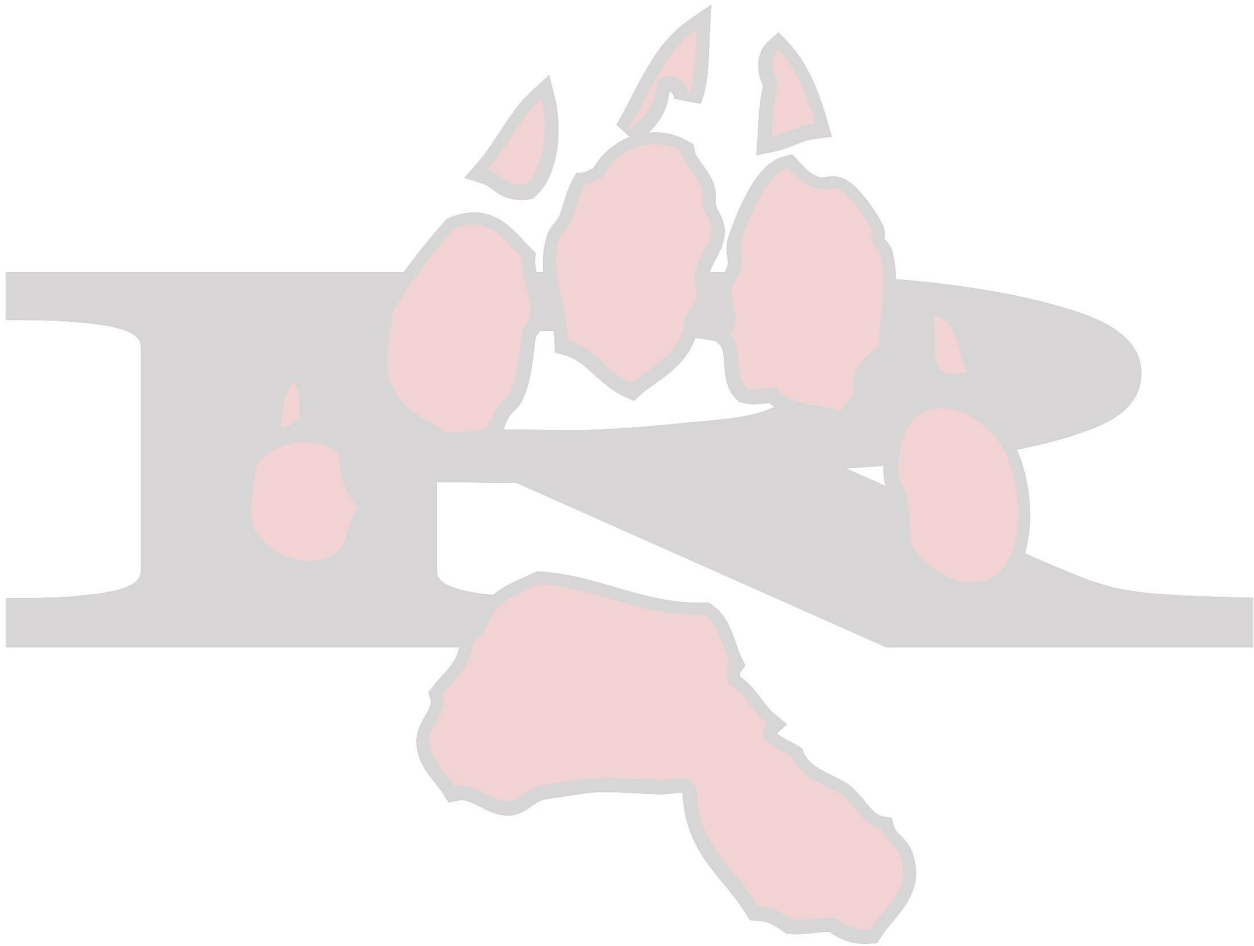
1. All Conference nominations shall be submitted to the commissioner by Wednesday prior to the State Tournament. Only all-conference selections will be considered for the all-state team.
2. The Head Coach may nominate no more than five (5) players for all-conference, but may not vote for their own players.
3. At the selection meeting lots will be drawn to determine the order in which nominees are presented. Each coach will then, in turn, present their nominees.
4. There will be only one (1) ballot. Each head coach shall vote for fifteen (15) nominees. Coaches may not vote for their own players. Roll call voting for All Conference and All State will take place on a rotational basis by school and by descending point order. Since there are fourteen (14) positions to be selected, voting will be 15-14-13-12-11-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Point totals will be tabulated with the fourteen (14) highest totals being First Team and all other point recipients being Second Team.
5. The conference tournament site will release a list of senior All-Star eligible athletes to the WCA Basketball sport rep by the Wednesday following the state tournament.
6. A press release of All Conference and All State players shall be made on the Wednesday following the State Tournament.
7. Coaches will distribute medals to their First Team All-Conference players after the press release.
8. The highest point getter will be selected as the conference player of the year and the state player of the year.

Coaches will select a conference coach of the year by a ballot, which will be voted on at the All-Conference meeting. Coaches will also select a Player of the Year by a ballot, which will be voted on at the All-Conference meeting.
