TOURNAMENT PACKET / COACHES MEETING

You may pick up your tournament packet at the coach's dinner at Storey Gym at 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday March 2nd or prior to your first game. Following the dinner there will be a coach's meeting at 6:00 p.m. for anyone in town. This is an opportunity for coaches to discuss anything that needs to be addressed and taken to their athletic directors for further discussion.

Head Coaches, assistants, and administrators are welcome to attend the meeting. Please email Mark Puev (mark.puev@laramie1.org) and let him know how many people will be attending from your school.

TEAM RECORD REPORT FORM (S1)

The team record report form (WHSAA Form S1) located on the WHSAA web page **MUST** be submitted to the regional director and the WHSAA by 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, February 27, 2022. Please email the information to the Tournament Director.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Seeding will be determined by final quadrant standings. Seeding will be 1-8 based on final quadrant standings. A completed bracket will be emailed as early as possible, Monday, February 28th.

No more than twelve (12) players may be in uniform for the Regional Basketball Tournament. The twelve (12) players that are entered in the official scorebook at the beginning of the first game shall be the only players used during the entire tournament.

PARKING

South High School - Busses can park on the North side of the school in the student parking lot.

Storey Gym – Busses can park in the parking lot on the South side of the LCSD#1 Admin. Building (2810 House Ave.).

GAME MANAGEMENT

The following will be provided:

1. Basketballs for warm-up
2. Water, cups, and ice
3. Training room
4. Locker Rooms

Towels will not be provided by South High School.

PICTURES AND ROSTERS

Team pictures with players and coaches identified need to be sent via e-mail to kate.tietjen@laramie1.org. Roster information also needs to be updated on MaxPreps and sent to tournament director. This needs to be completed no later than Friday, February 18, 2022.

SEATING

The visiting bench will be to the right of the scorer's table (as you look at the scorer's table); the home bench will be to the left of the scorer's table. Student's seating will be behind their respective team benches or directly across from their team. **South High School will always sit on the home bench.**

- Storey Gym
 - Student seating will be behind visitors' bench and across from home bench
 - Teams that are on deck to play will have reserved seating behind the scorer's table and home bench on the south side of the gym
 - A section will be made available for bands upon request of any schools. Contact the tournament director for your bands request. We ask that bands make arrangements to quickly move in and out of their sections so the next band can set up.
- South High School
 - Student seating will be behind visitors' bench and across from home bench
 - No bands will be allowed to play at South High School

HALFTIME

If you have a group (cheerleaders, dance team, band) that would like to perform at a halftime, please have them contact Mark Puev (mark.puev@laramie1.org) to schedule a game to perform at. It will be done on a first come first serve basis. We need to know this ahead of time, so we can accommodate as many groups as possible.

Teams that are on deck will be allowed on the floor to shoot during halftime.

No dunking at halftime, warm-ups, or between games of tournament play or regular game play as per the 4A Bylaws. (Dunking only permitted within regulation game time).

VIDEOTAPING

Videotaping can be done at the top of either set of bleachers at South High or Storey Gym.

RADIO

Home and away radio stations will be seated at the media tables on the top of the bleachers on either side of the gym at South High School or in the media boxes at Storey Gym. Radio stations need to contact the tournament director by Friday February 25th to request space. These spaces will be reserved on a first come first serve basis.

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be assigned before each game. Laramie County School District #1 will not be responsible for lost or missing items. Teams will be given a key to their assigned locker room. Please make sure all keys are returned as soon as possible after each game. Locker rooms will be available at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday. For the remainder of the tournament, locker rooms will be available approximately one hour prior to the scheduled game time.

WARM-UP

A minimum of 10 minutes will be allowed for warm-ups. Fifteen will be given if the previous game ends more than 15 minutes before the starting time of the next game.

The Eastridge facility will be available for practice, warm-ups, and shoot-a-rounds. Please contact Mark Puev (mark.puev@laramie1.org) to set up times to use the Eastridge facility.

ATHLETIC TRAINER AND TRAINING ROOM

A certified athletic trainer will be available for all games. Please bring your own training supplies. Their locations will be:

Storey gym: South side of the basketball court

South High School: North side of the basketball court

HOME/VISITING TEAM DESIGNATIONS

The higher seeded team will be the HOME team, wear white uniforms, and occupy the bench to the left of the scorer's table as you face the table.

AWARDS

Coach of the Year, Player of the Year, the Conference Championship Plaque, and the Regional Plates will be presented at the conclusion of each of the respective games.

HOSPITALITY ROOM

A hospitality room will be set up in Room 131. It will be for coaches, bus drivers, tournament workers and school administrators; please no students. There will be no Hospitality Room for games at South High School.

CONCESSIONS

Concessions will be provided throughout the tournament.

4A LEAGUE BY-LAWS APPLYING TO REGIONAL BASKETBALL

Tiebreaking Procedures:

1. Head-to-head conference competition between and among the tied teams.
2. If a tie still exists, compare the records of the tied teams against the record of the highest-ranking non-tied team. Continue through the Conference standings until the tie is broken.
3. If a tie still exists, head-to-head conference competition between the tied teams at common sites. (Season Tournaments)
4. If a tie still exists, compare the records of the tied teams against the record of the highest ranking 4A non-conference opponent at a neutral site. Continue through the 4A non-conference standings until the tie is broken.
5. If a tie still exists, compare the records of the tied teams against the record of the highest ranking 4A non-conference opponent. Continue through the 4A nonconference standings until the tie is broken.
6. If a tie still exists, compare the records of the tied teams against the record of common opponents at common sites.
7. If a tie still exists, the tie shall be broken with the flip of a coin.
8. If it is a four-way tie, go to the WHSAA rulebook Rule 7.4.8 on Page 39.

The coaches will select an All-Conference team and an All-State team the Tuesday following the state tournament. The meeting will be held in Casper and will be run by the commissioner of that sport. The all-conference and all-state selections will be determined in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. All Conference nominations shall be submitted to the commissioner by Wednesday prior to the State Tournament. Only all-conference selections will be considered for the all-state team.
2. The Head Coach may nominate no more than five (5) players for all-conference, but may not vote for their own players.
3. At the selection meeting lots will be drawn to determine the order in which nominees are presented. Each coach will then, in turn, present their nominees.
4. There will be only one (1) ballot. Each head coach shall vote for fifteen (15) nominees. Coaches may not vote for their own players. Roll call voting for All Conference and All State will take place on a rotational basis by school and by descending point order. Since there are fourteen (14) positions to be selected, voting will be 15-14-13-12-11-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Point totals will be tabulated with the fourteen (14) highest totals being First Team and all other point recipients being Second Team.

5. The conference tournament site will release a list of senior All-Star eligible athletes to the WCA Basketball sport rep by the Wednesday following the state tournament.
6. A press release of All Conference and All State players shall be made on the Wednesday following the State Tournament.
7. Coaches will distribute medals to their First Team All-Conference players after the press release.
8. The highest point getter will be selected as the conference player of the year and the state player of the year.

Coaches will select a conference coach of the year by a ballot, which will be voted on at the All-Conference meeting. Coaches will also select a Player of the Year by a ballot, which will be voted on at the All-Conference meeting.

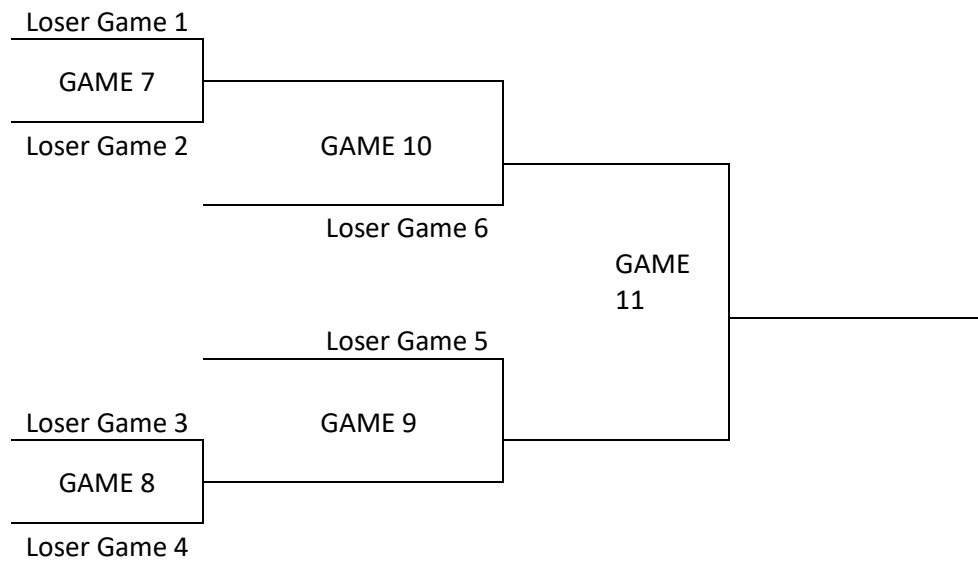
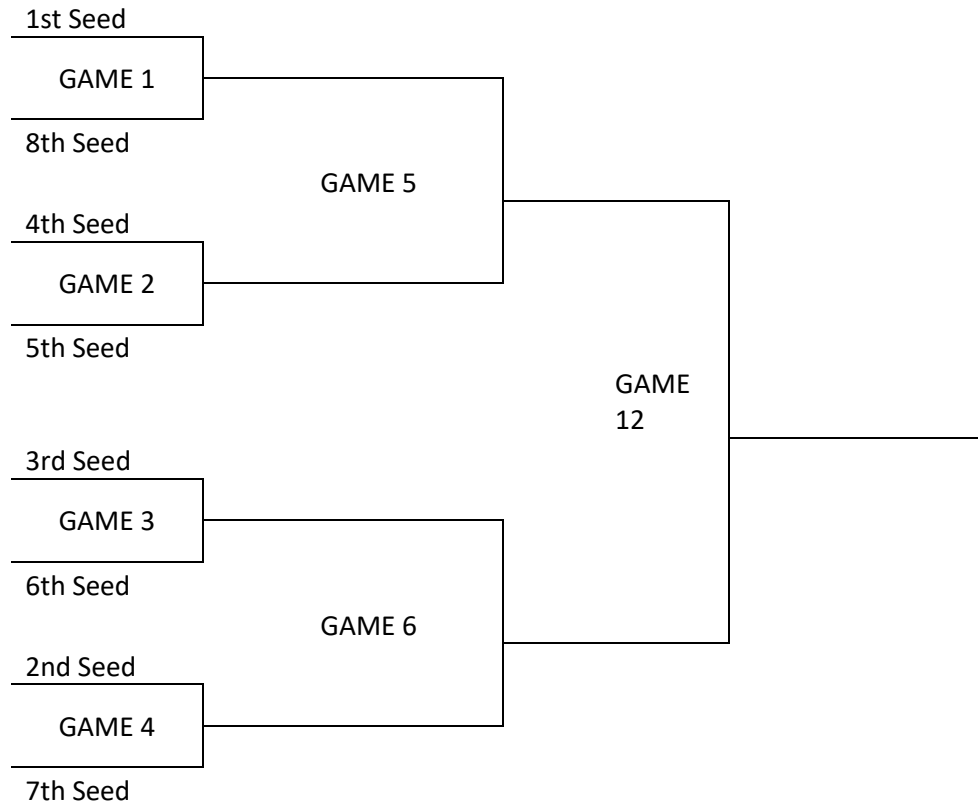

2022 4A East Regional Bracket Set Up:

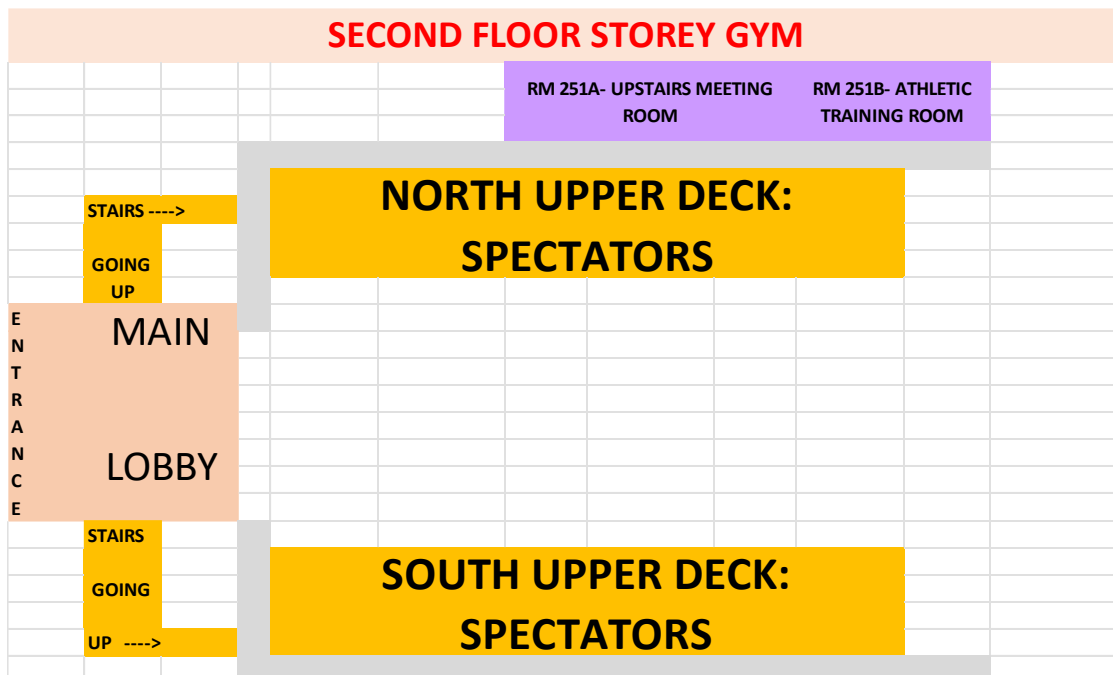
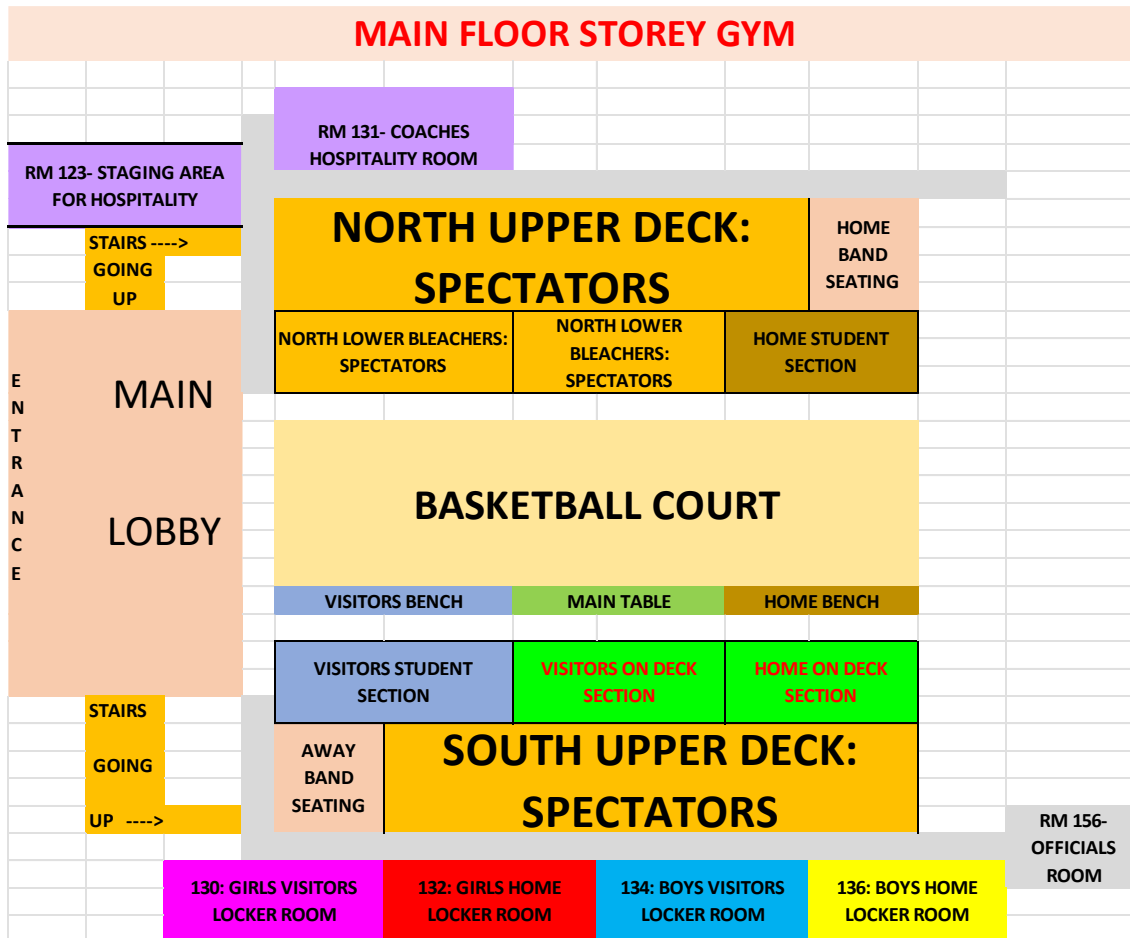
*4A will utilize an 8 team, double elimination bracket for the 4A Regional Tournament. We will use the conference regular season win/loss record to determine seeding (1-8).

STOREY GYM MAP-

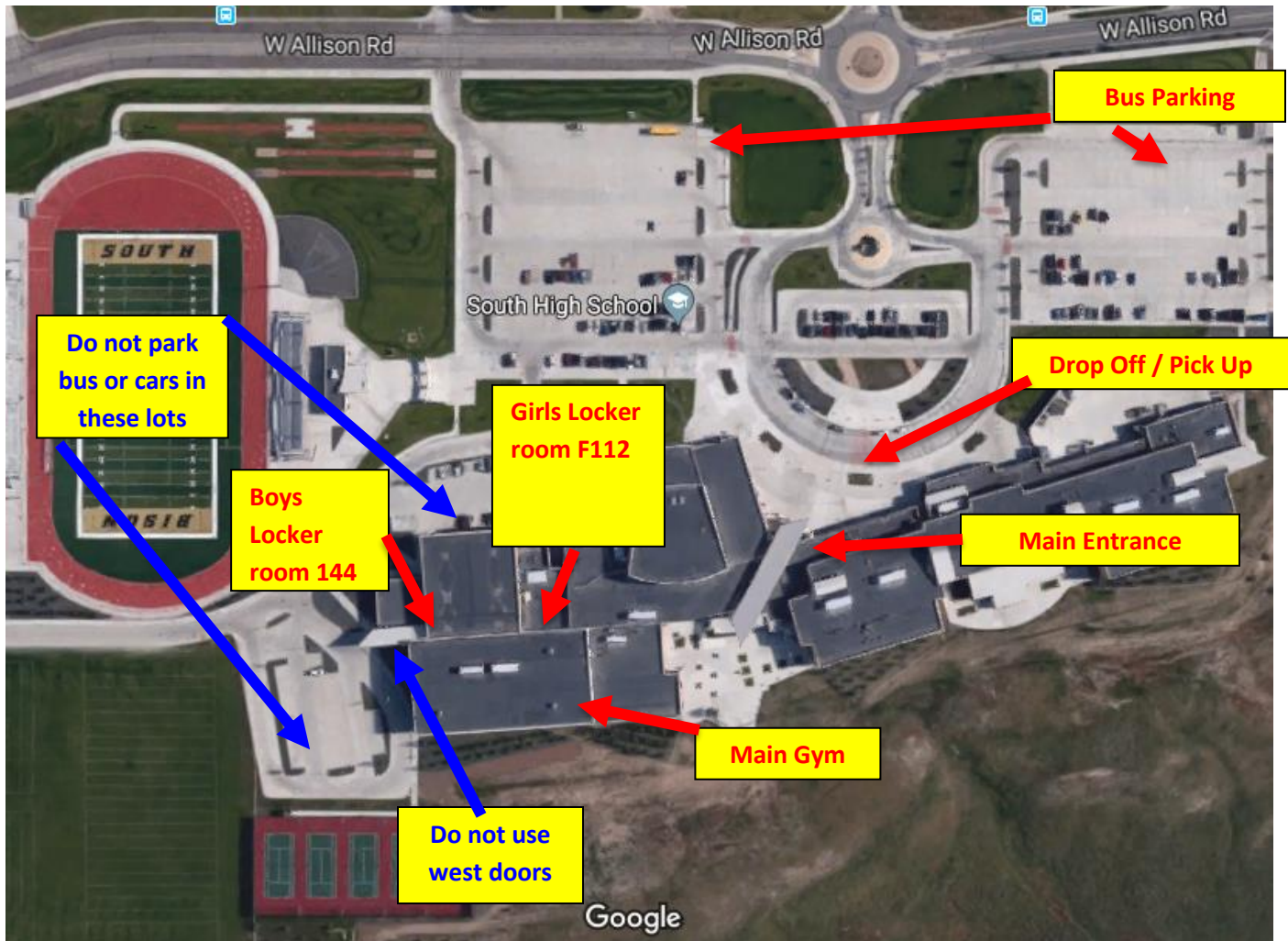


STOREY GYM ENTRANCE AND PARKING:

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

RESPONSE PROTOCOL – Storey Gymnasium

AED Location:	1) Located on the north side of the entrance area 2) Portable AED available with the Athletic Trainer in the SE corner of the gymnasium
EMS Access Point:	East entrance of Storey gymnasium
EMS Cross Street:	E. Pershing Blvd. & Evans Ave.
EMS Directions:	From Pershing Blvd. turn south on Evans Ave. Enter Storey gym at east entrance located off of Evans Ave.
Tornado:	Stay calm and shelter in gymnasium or locker rooms until threat is clear as notified by AT, AD, or administration.

In the event of a cardiac emergency the first trained Event Staff member on the scene will take control of the situation and provide directions to others as outlined below.

Lead Responder

If someone collapses, is not breathing normally, and is unresponsive to shaking, initiate response protocol:

1. Instruct someone by name to call 911.
2. Instruct someone by name to retrieve the AED.
3. Instruct someone by name to meet EMS at EMS access point.
4. Instruct someone by name to call staff numbers list.
5. Position the person on his/her back.
6. Put one hand on top of the other in the middle of the victim's chest. Keeping your arms straight, push hard and fast, at about 100 presses a minute. Let the chest completely recoil after each compression.
7. Take turns doing CPR with fellow responders. Keep CPR interruptions to a minimum.
8. Once the AED arrives, turn it on, and follow the voice prompts.
 - a. Remove clothing from chest.
 - b. Attach electrode pads as directed by the voice prompts.
 - c. Stand clear while the AED analyzes the heart rhythm.
 - d. Keep the area clear if the AED advises a shock.
 - e. Follow the device prompts for further action.
 - f. After EMS takes charge of the victim, deliver AED to EMS for ED physician delivery.
