WYOMING SPORTS OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1. Graduating high school senior whose parent(s) are current members of the WSOA. Applicants must have at least a 2.5 GPA and participate in extra curricular activities.
- 2. Two \$500.00 Scholarships will be awarded to students planning to attend an accredited vocational-technical school or college. High school graduates may apply, but priority will be given to current high school seniors.
- 3. Application must contain transcripts, goals, plans, and an essay of not less than 100 words on "The impact that activities play in the education of students".

 Application will be accepted through March 1st.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation: one letter from a high school teacher, coach or sports official and one letter from a community leader.
- 5. The WSOA Scholarship Selection Committee will select the scholarship recipients at their March Board Meeting.
- 6. Scholarship will be paid on the following terms:
 - A. The student must enroll on a fulltime basis (12 credit hours) in the next regular semester of college following graduation or by September 30th.
 - B. One hundred percent of the scholarship will be paid with proof of enrollment for the first semester.
