Subject: 2024 State 3A Soccer Information

The Boys and Girls State 3A Soccer Brackets, as per WHSAA Rule 7.11.42, can be found on the WHSAA website (www.whsaa.org). We will also email out the final bracket to AD's and Coaches on Monday, May 13th.

Soccer Team Roster - Please email your varsity boys and girls soccer rosters and team photos to Ruth DeWick at: ruth.dewick@swcsd2.org or to Tony Beardsley at: anthony.beardsley@swcsd2.org by no later than 3:00pm on Monday, May 13th, 2024.

Team Bench – The home team will be the first team listed on the bracket (team on top of the bracket), and will use the team bench that is located on the right side of the field when facing the press box/head table/bleachers. For those teams that are immediately to compete following a game prior to them, a minimum of a 15-minute warm-up will be allowed on the game field.

Roster Limits - No more than twenty-two (22) players can be in uniform for any post season tournament contest. The twenty-two players whose names are entered on the official scorebook/roster for the first tournament contest, shall be the only players used for the entire tournament.

Locker Rooms – Locker Rooms will be issued for each team at each venue. Information on locker room assignments will be emailed to 3A Soccer Coaches and Athletic Directors prior to the State 3A Tournament. Bus Parking – Please see attached maps for bus drop off and parking areas at each venue.

Team Packets – Team packets can be picked up at the location of your first match.

Hospitality Room – Food items will be provided for officials and Coaches at both venues. Team packets will provide coaches with information on specific locations of Hospitality areas.

Concessions – Concessions and/or Food Vendors will be available at Green River High School as well as at Wolves Stadium (Lincoln Middle School) throughout the tournament. Concessions and Vendors will follow all WHSAA and SWCSD#2 Guidelines.

Sports Medicine – Each venue will be staffed with a Certified Athletic Trainer and/or a local Sports Physical Therapist provided by Sweetwater County School District #2 and Fremont Therapy Group of Green River, Wyoming.

Tournament Ball – The official tournament ball is the Baden LEXUM SX751.

Uniforms – Teams on the top of the bracket will be designated home team for each match and wear the dark colored uniforms.

Awards – Team awards will be presented after each contest on Saturday.

Coaches Meeting – There will be a Girls Coaches Meeting at GRHS in the PLC Room (we will provide information on the location of this room later) on Thursday, May 16th, at 5:00pm to determine 3A Girls All-Conference and All-State Soccer teams. If your coach cannot attend, we can offer a zoom option. There will be a Boys Coaches Meeting at GRHS in the PLC Room on Thursday, May 16th, at 7:00pm to determine All-Conference and All-State soccer teams. Specific information will be emailed to coaches prior to the State Tournament.

Practice Fields – Grass Practice field areas are available. We will NOT be using any of the game fields for practice as this is a violation of the WHSAA Handbook. 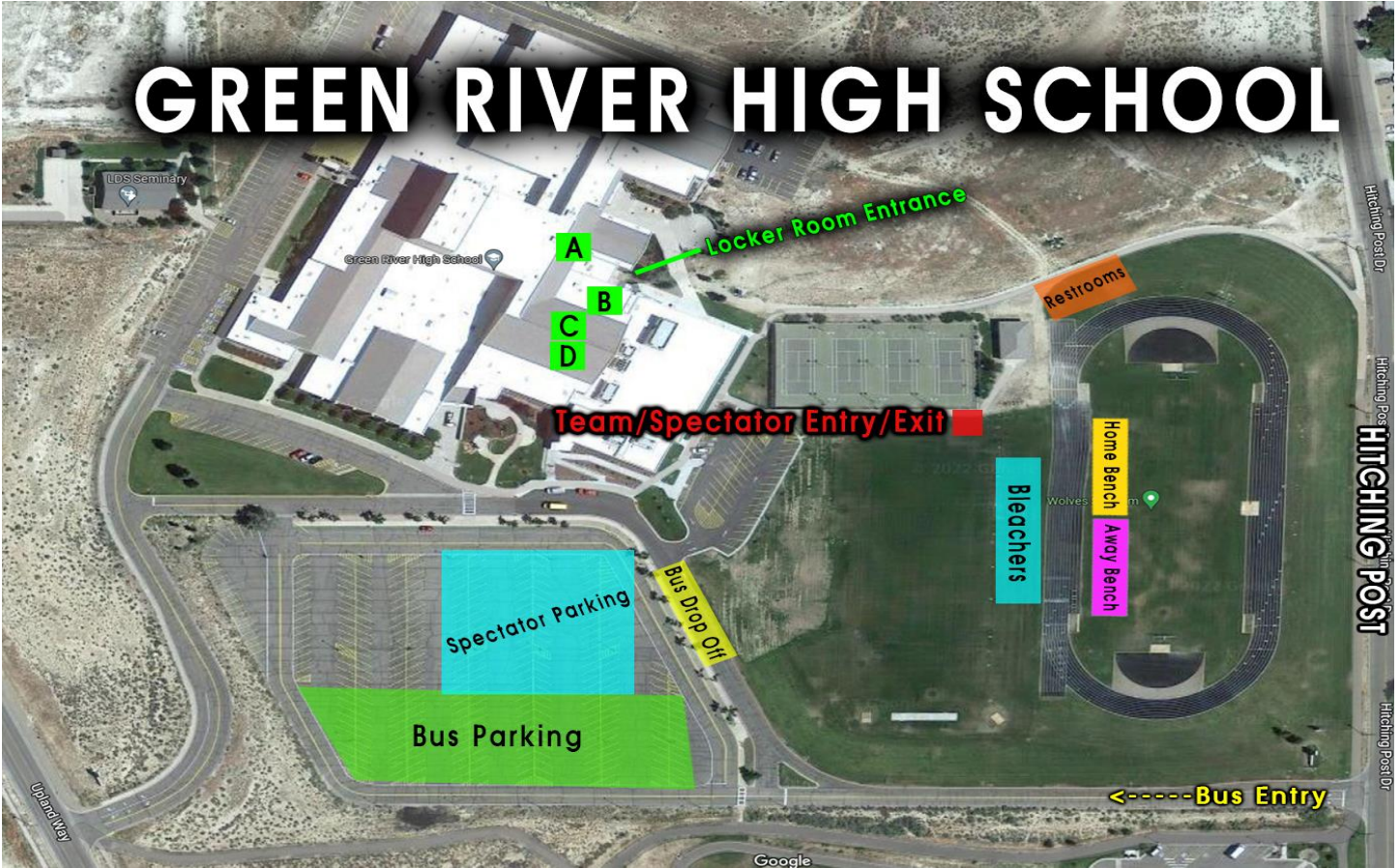

Spine Boarding Procedures:	Athletic Trainer and/or Sports Physical Therapist will take control of the head/neck and will instruct a coach or administrator to call 911 or retrieve EMT (if they are onsite) to come with spine board and gurney. The Athletic Trainer and/or Sports Physical Therapist will take lead while spine boarding and instruct coaches and administrators to help as needed. The coaches and administrators that are not hands on with the athlete will keep athletes and spectators away from the injured athlete so we may keep the athlete as safe as possible. Under NO circumstance will we let ANYONE other than uniformed EMT on site around the athlete to assist.
