Game Day Rosters - No more than twenty-two (22) players can be in uniform for any post season tournament contest. The twenty-two players whose names are entered on the official scorebook/roster for the first tournament contest, shall be the only players used for the entire tournament. Violation of this provision shall cause forfeiture as per WHSAA Rules 5.0.7 and 1.4.0.

Locker Rooms - High school and junior high school locker rooms will be available. Check with Byron Bolen if you play at Rock Springs High School or Mike Lopiccolo if you play at Rock Springs Junior High School.

Bus Parking - Please see attached maps for bus parking at each venue. Bus Parking will be limited on Thursday due to classes being held.

Team Packets - Team packets can be picked up at the location of your first game. If you are going to watch a game at a different location, please let Mr. Bolen know and your packet will be available at that location.

Hospitality Room - Meals will be provided for officials, coaches and meet workers at both locations.

Concessions - A concessions stand will be provided at both Rock Springs High School and Rock Springs Junior High.

Sports Medicine - Each venue will be staffed with a certified athletic trainer provided by Rock Springs High School and /or Rocky Mountain Sports & Physical Therapy.

Tournament Ball - The official tournament ball is the Baden LEXUM SX751.

Coaches Meeting for All State Voting - The coaches will select an All-State team Thursday, May 16, 2024 at 7pm in the aerobics room at Rock Spring High School. Dinner will be served. Arrangements will be made for coaches who cannot attend this meeting via video conference. Uniforms–Teams on the top of the bracket will be designated home team for the game and wear their dark colored uniforms and occupy the bench to the right, as you look at the weather enclosures.

Practice Fields – Practice fields can be available next to each of the game fields. Please note these are grass fields and are not full size fields but suffice enough for a warm-up. Spine Boarding Procedures:	Athletic Trainer will take control of the head/neck and will instruct a coach or administrator to call 911 or retrieve EMT (if they are onsite) to come with spine board and gurney. The Athletic Trainer will take lead while spine boarding and instruct coaches and administrators to help as needed. The coaches and administrators that are not hands on with the athlete will keep athletes and spectators away from the injured athlete so we may keep the athlete as safe as possible. Under NO circumstance will we let ANYONE other than uniformed EMT on site around the athlete to assist.
