TOURNAMENT PACKET

Team packets can be picked up at the location of your first game (Wolves Stadium or GRHS) of the tournament on Thursday. Included in the packet will be basic tournament information, All-Conference meeting information, initial brackets, and a tournament program.

TEAM RECORD REPORT FORM (S2)

The team record report form (WHSAA Form S2) is located on the WHSAA web page. I will also share the form with AD's and Coaches along with this packet. This form <u>MUST</u> be submitted to the regional director by 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 11th. This will assist in seeding the Regional tournament and getting brackets in place and on the WHSAA website (with the exception of the play-in game). When filling out the form, please indicate if the game is a "quad" game. List all "quad" games as well as "cross-quad" games in case there is a tie in seeding. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

4A will utilize an 8-team bracket with the #1 seed receiving a first-round bye and automatic bid to the state tournament. Teams who lose in the first round are eliminated. The remaining four teams will play a semifinal, final, and $3^{rd}/4^{th}$ place game to determine seeding for the state tournament. In the 4A West, the #7 and #8 seeded teams at the conclusion of the season will play a Regional "Play-In" game on the Tuesday of the Regional tournament week. The #7 seeded team will host this game and the winner will advance to the 4A West Regional tournament on May 15 – 17th, 2025.

No more that twenty-two (22) players <u>can be in uniform</u> for any post season tournament contest. The twenty-two players whose names are entered on the official scorebook/roster for the first tournament contest, shall be the only players used for the entire tournament as per WHSAA Handbook policy. These players cannot be replaced for any reason and the team must finish the tournament with these players.

PARKING

Wolves Stadium - Busses and spectators can park in the back lot of Lincoln Middle School **see attached map for bus parking and drop off area for Wolves Stadium

Green River High School – Busses/spectators can park along the outside areas of the GRHS parking lot **see attached map for bus drop off and parking area for GRHS

GAME MANAGEMENT

There will be a Supervisor at each field during the tournament. The supervisor can assist teams in locating locker rooms, the athletic trainer, and team bench areas. Teams will rotate through the various locker rooms, therefore, it is recommended that teams do not leave items in locker rooms and only use them to dress out for their games. We will have water and ice available near each team bench. Towels will not be provided by Green River High School. ****See attached maps for specifics on locker room locations and team bench locations.**

PICTURES AND ROSTERS

Team pictures with players and coaches identified need to be sent via e-mail to the tournament director. This needs to be completed no later than Thursday, May 8th, 2025 at 7:00pm. The team photo and roster you send for the tournament program does not need to be the same as your final team roster that you give to the officials at your first game. TEAM BENCH SEATING

See attached maps for team bench locations. When standing at the head table of the field and looking out onto the field, the home bench is on the left of the head table and the visiting bench on the right.

<u>HALFTIME</u>

NO teams will be allowed on the field to warm-up during halftime. Teams can use grass areas that surround both of our fields to warm-up while games are being played. We have large areas of grass that can be utilized. Please check the areas you use for safety prior to warming up. Supervisors at each venue can also assist teams with finding warm-up locations.

VIDEOTAPING

Videotaping can be done at the top of either set of bleachers at the Stadium or the High School. We will also record all games at Wolves Stadium on our Hudl sideline camera system. Both fields will be live streamed on the NFHS Network for those individuals with a subscription. Field Supervisors can also assist coaches in finding a good location to film. Power outlets can be difficult to find.

RADIO/MEDIA

Media areas at Wolves Stadium are located in the visitors press box. Media can set up near the head table or another area near the head table at Green River High School. This event is live streamed on the NFHS Network. No Media outlets can video stream the games without written consent from the NFHS Network prior to the tournament. <u>https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/</u>

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be assigned for each game. Sweetwater County School District #1 will not be responsible for lost or missing items. Locker rooms will be shared and opened for the teams playing the next game after halftime of the game being played. Teams should not leave any items in locker rooms.

WARM-UP

A minimum of 15 minutes will be allowed for warm-ups. Team will be able to begin warming up on the grass fields surrounding each playing field at both Wolves Stadium and Green River High School.

TRAINING ROOM

Athletic Training areas will be open and available for use throughout the tournament. A certified athletic trainer or sports physical therapist will be available for all games. Please bring your own training supplies. Field Supervisors can assist coaches and players in finding the Athletic Trainer.

HOME/VISITING TEAM DESIGNATIONS

The team listed on the top side of the bracket will be the HOME team for the match and wear their dark uniform.

ALL-CONFERENCE & COACH OF THE YEAR

Coaches must have their all-conference nominations to the tournament director by Tuesday, May 13th at 7:00 p.m. Please also submit your coach of the year ballot with the all-conference nominations. Information and Forms will be sent out prior to the week of regionals to allow coaches to nominate their players and also to vote for Coach of the Year.

ALL CONFERENCE MEETING

The All-Conference meetings will begin at 7:00pm on Thursday, May 15th, at Green River High School Media Center. We will have cheerleaders meeting and greeting coaches at the front doors of GRHS to help escort or provide directions to you. The purpose of this meeting is to select the All-Conference Team and Conference Coach of the Year, and to gather any suggestions that may need to be discussed at the State level. Dinner will be provided. Head Coaches, assistants, and administrators are welcome to attend the meeting. Please email Tony Beardsley at <u>anthony.beardsley@swcsd2.org</u> and let him know how many people will be attending from your school.

<u>AWARDS</u>

Team Awards will be handed out to each team following the Championship game and the 3rd Place game. Coach of the Year and All-Conference medals will be handed out to coaches at the All-Conference meetings following final voting.

HOSPITALITY ROOM

Hospitality areas will be provided for all officials, workers, coaches, administrators, and bus drivers. Hospitality area at GRHS will be located in the garage/shed next to the field. At Wolves Stadium, the hospitality area will be at the Concessions stand.

CONCESSIONS

There will either be concessions or vendors at each field during the tournament.

TOURNAMENT BALL

The official tournament ball is the Baden PERFECTION.

4A LEAGUE BY-LAWS APPLYING TO REGIONAL SOCCER

- j. The coaches will select an All-Conference team and an All-State team at each respective tournament. <u>The all-conference selection will be determined in accordance with the following guidelines:</u>
- 1. All-Conference nominations shall be submitted to the commissioner prior to the regional tournament.
- 2. The Head Coach may nominate his own players but may not vote for them.
- 3. Positions selected for the All-Conference team shall be as follows:
 - a. 3 Goal Keepers
 - b. 6 Forwards
 - c. 8 Midfielders
 - d. 8 Defenders

- 4. Any player nominated for All-Conference must have played that position sometime during the season.
- 5. At the selection meeting, lots will be drawn to determine the order in which nominees are presented. Each coach will then, in turn, present their nominees. This will be done for each position.
- 6. There will be only one (1) ballot. Each head coach shall vote for 25 nominees. Coaches may not vote for their own players. Roll call voting for All-Conference and All-State will take place on a rotational basis by school. If there are three positions to be selected, voting will be 4-3-2-1. If there are six positions to be selected, voting will be 7-6-5-4-3-2-1. If there are eight positions to be selected, voting will be 9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Point totals will be tabulated with the highest total being First Team and all other point recipients being Second Team.

**The coaches will turn in their all-conference nominations to the regional tournament director prior to the Regional Tournament. The tournament director will then provide a form to the coaches with all nominees. This will allow coaches the opportunity to review and research the nominated athletes prior to the all-conference meeting.

- 7. A press release of All-Conference players will be released the Monday following the state tournament and a press release of All-State players will be released the Tuesday following the state tournament.
- k. Coaches will select a Coach of the Year by ballot, which will be voted on at the All-Conference meeting.
- I. Conference standings and tiebreaking procedures will follow WHSAA Rule 7.11.42.
- m. The Regional Tournament will follow WHSAA Rule 7.11.0.
- A West will have a play in game between the #7 and #8 seeds on the Tuesday of regional week with the winner qualifying for the regional tournament and the loser being eliminated. Following the play in game the 4A West will utilize an 8-team bracket with the 1 seed receiving a first-round bye and automatic bid to the state tournament. Teams who lose in the first round are eliminated. The remaining four teams will play a semifinal, final, and 3rd/4th place game to determine seeding for the state tournament. Regional hosts will utilize two fields when available.

4A East will utilize an 8-team bracket with the 1 seed receiving a first-round bye and automatic bid to the state tournament. Teams who lose in the first round are eliminated. The remaining four teams will play a semifinal, final, and 3rd/4th place game to determine seeding for the state tournament. Regional hosts will utilize two fields when available.
