### **Team Packets**

Packets will be available for pick up on your arrival.

### **Tournament Passes**

Each team will receive the following passes for the tournament. Please have them visible when entering the building: 14 player passes, 2 manager passes, 2 coach passes, 1 bus driver pass, and 2 spouse passes.

### **Matches**

All matches will be played at the RHS Wolverine Gym and RMS Spartan Gym.

### **Seeding**

Please submit the Team Record Report Form (WHSAA Form S1) by the deadline so that brackets can be seeded as soon as possible.

### **Bracket**

The home team is the top team on the bracket.

### **Team Picture and Roster**

All rosters and team pictures should be on DragonFly and sent to Max Mills of Shoshoni for development of a program.

### **Rosters**

WHSAA Rule 7.15.61: No more than fourteen players can be in uniform for any contest. The fourteen players whose names are entered on the official scorebook for the first tournament contest, shall be the only players used for the entire tournament. Violation of this provision shall cause forfeiture as per WHSAA Rules 5.07 and 1.4.0.

### **Pregame Warmup**

Warmups will be 7-7 for each match.

### **Video**

An area for videotaping will be provided for filming on both baselines and in the crowd's nest. You will need to provide your own extension cord.

### **Locker Rooms**

Locker Rooms will be assigned, but also shared. Please take belongings with you. Fremont County School District 25 will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Towels will not be provided.

### **Water**

Water and cups will be provided at the end of the bench. Water containers must be screw-top or snap-on lids and must be non-glass.

### **Hospitality Room**

A hospitality room will be provided for officials, coaches, administrators, spouses and bus drivers only. The room is located in our choir room across from the gym. It is not intended for families.

### **Ticket Prices**

Prices are set by the WHSAA. Only WHSAA passes are valid for this event; other passes will not work.

### **Coaches Meeting**

### **Bus Parking**

Please unload your athletes on the east side of the high school and the north side of the middle school. Please park buses in the west parking lot after unloading for the high school and on the north parking lot for the middle school. Please keep buses locked or supervised at all times. ### **Banners/Noisemakers**

Banners, signs and artificial noisemakers are not allowed at the tournament site. Please remind your fans.

### **Officials**

Officials are assigned by the WHSAA.

### **Concessions**

Concessions will be available during both days of the tournament.

### **NFHS Network**

Both Riverton High School and Riverton Middle School gyms are part of the NFHS Network and will be available for the tournament.

### **Awards**

Awards will be presented immediately following the award matches. Name plates will be awarded to teams finishing in the top four. Individual medals will be awarded to the 1A West and 2A West Regional Champions. All awards are provided by the WHSAA.
