RULE 7.12.73 – STATE SWIMMING AND DIVING ENTRY AND PLACING PROPOSAL

MOTION: Mr. Carr moved and Mrs. Mills seconded the motion to approve the proposed wording change to Rule 7.12.73 as follows:

Each school may enter only four athletes in each event and no more than one team in each relay. The only way a school may enter more than four athletes in an event is if all athletes have met the qualifying standard in that event. All athletes are eligible to advance and place in the consolation or championship finals in swimming and the final 12 in diving. Only four athletes from each school may score per event.

RULE 5.4.5 – DEAD PERIOD CAMP APPROVAL

MOTION: Mr. Carr moved and Mrs. Mills seconded the motion to approve the proposed wording change to Rule 5.4.5 as follows:

There shall be no participation in a specialized sports camp/clinic the two weeks prior to the beginning of a sport season if the student's coach(es) is a clinician.

Exception: A coach may run a camp for the youth (non-high school) of their community and use their high school players to assist, during the two weeks prior to the beginning of a sport season, provided there is no direct instruction to the high school players.
